




PWR Off: Power Off

changes working frequency at the same time.


2nd Funtion: Press button over 10s, device reset.

2. Short press the **Button** of Q2300E to set the same number to match successfully






4 PTMP Setting

5 Web configuration

- 1. Check all wires are correctly connected.
- 2. Configure the host system with static IP on the 10.x.x.x (x could be 10–254) subnet, netmask 255.0.0.0
- 3. Use the discovery tool to scan the IP of the device.(wait a few seconds after device power up).
- Using a web browser access the device IP
